 - a. Day One SKILLZ program runs June 6 July 6, with 100 kids participating, at Lake Avenue Church; their Space Race fundraising event is coming up on June 10 at Hahamongna Park; also working on anti-bullying work, among many other initiatives; with new requirement for students to have community service hours, they are tracking the hours youth participate and help in their programs
 - b. CAP tracking number of students who get put into remedial writing classes as college freshmen; last day of programs this week; there are complications for parents/students filling out FAFSA forms; they are tracking the kids they work with, for summer data reporting
 - c. Altadena Library Summer Reading Program registration begins today; they have a new reading tracking app called Bean Stack; June 10 is the celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the Library; recently completed six months of community conversations led by Brian Biery and shared final report at Town Hall meeting; identified 11 top priorities and now strategizing on moving forward
